Suggested Home Learning in the event of school closures due to inclement weather.

This is NOT compulsory home learning

Literacy

Reading to an adult - this could be any text if school reading book is unavailable.

- Discuss text read, use of language, spelling patterns and your child's opinions on what they have read.

A piece of descriptive writing about what they can see from any window in their house.

- Focus on the use of interesting adjectives and verbs (WOW words), similes and correct spelling and sentence structure.

20 minute short writing task.

- Imagine you are a wild animal. How do you feel about the snow? Explain your feelings.
- How much has the snow affected your ability to keep warm and find food and drink?

Numeracy

Times Tables

- Rapid recall of 'Times Tables' and associated division facts
- Clubs - these are available on the school website

Shapes

- Draw different polygons (2D shapes with straight edges) and write their properties.

e.g. **Square**

4 right angles, quadrilateral, a regular shape

4 equal sides, 4 lines of symmetry



Temperature

- If possible measure the outside temperature during the day
